You have 8 courses that you must undertake this year if you are a full-time student <u>and</u> have successfully completed <u>all</u> your Year 1 courses in 2020.

If you have failed any courses in 2020 <u>or</u> if you have been provided with an individualised programme planner, please seek advice from Education Student Centre advisors <u>before</u> enrolling in courses for 2021.

Please enrol in both semesters one and two.

Summer School enrolment is for those who need to resit the following courses.

General Education:

You may take ENGLISH 121G or any other General Education course available from the appropriate schedules, i.e. <u>either</u> the Open schedule <u>or</u> the Education and Social Work schedule - see details following. Go to <u>www.auckland.ac.nz/uoa/cs-general-education</u> to find out what General Education courses are available. Choose a course that does <u>not</u> clash with your BEd(Tchg) Primary timetable. Please allow for travelling time if the course you select is taught at the City campus.

Only courses with the **G suffix** from the Open and Education & Social Work Schedules satisfy the General Education requirement. Also note that you must select courses from outside of your degree area (i.e. no identical course codes e.g. EDUC 100G and EDUC 114)
