

2020 Timetable and Enrolment Information

Graduate Diploma in Teaching (Secondary)

Welcome to the Faculty of Education and Social Work at the University of Auckland. As you have accepted a place in the programme (i.e. you are matriculated), you now need to enrol in the courses for the year.

You should enrol as follows:

- Log into Student Services Online www.studentservices.auckland.ac.nz
- **150 Total Points** the total number of points required for the programme is a minimum of 150
- Enrol in your courses in the following order (you can only enrol one semester at a time):
 - 1. EDCURSEC 692 + your designated workshop. Please refer to your email for the class numbers.
 - 2. EDCURSEC 691 + your designated workshop. Please refer to your email for the class numbers.
 - 3. EDPROFST 613, EDPROFST 614A & B, EDUC 603A & B, EDPROFM 600A & B, EDPRAC 600A & B, EDUCM 199 (Select only one class either semester one or two). You will need to select the lecture and a workshop for each course. Some courses will have multiple workshops and you will need to choose ONE that suits you. You will need to enrol in the lecture, field, and workshop for the EDPRAC 600A and B course.


IMPORTANT:

 - o When your enrolment is complete you will be able to view your correct timetable.*




Step 1

The following home page will appear:




- 1. Click on the "Enrol" tab.

NB: The system will automatically direct you to Semester 1. Simply click on "Change" if you wish to enrol in a different semester.




3. Refer to the email or enrolment guide you were sent and enter in the appropriate class number and then click "Search by Class Number" as shown below:
