

1. Bogus Institutions

Suspicions intensify over elusive European Academy of Sciences

It may be flattering to be asked to join what the organizers claim is the "most distinguished group of scientists of this century". But if you get an invitation, then beware. Researchers across the world have received letters in recent months congratulating them on being elected to the European Academy of Sciences, and asking for US\$115 registration fees. But an investigation by Nature has established that the organization may not be all that it seems.

According to the letters, election to the academy is "one of the highest honours that can be accorded a scientist or engineer". Researchers will be able to take part in academy-funded projects and submit papers to its publications. The academy's website says the organization "promotes the establishment of new scientific laboratories and institutions" and collaborates with "national academies, universities and research centres of various European countries".

But Nature has been unable to find any record of the academy's publications, projects or meetings, and cannot confirm the scientific credentials of those behind it. The academy, which is not related to the Vienna-based Furnmen Academy of Sciences and Arts

Who's Who in Australia Registry

A scam that appeals to the professional ego is circulating by fax offering recipients a listing in the "Who's Who among Executives, Professionals and Entrepreneurs in Australia."

The fax informs the recipient that they have been 'researched' and 'selected among thousands of accomplished individuals', even though the fax is sent to a generic 'Director/Manager'.

To make sure they have the correct details, the recipient must fill out their personal details and fax it back.


Although the listing is supposedly free in this fake publication, those who fill out the form are then contacted and urged to upgrade their listing at a significant cost and to provide credit card details. A phone search by WA ScamNet revealed the fax was sent through a computer faxing service used by the unknown scammers who are probably operating from overseas.

WA ScamNet recommends receivers of these invitations to be wary, especially if they do not display a registered business name, an ABN number, street address or contact details. Also be careful who you give your personal details to.

The real Who's Who business registries are published by Crown Content Pty Ltd, based in Victoria. The company is aware of this scam and has issued a public warning.

Meetings That Flatter, but May Not Deliver

The e-mails come from Amber, Rainy, Dora, and Arlene. "How are you doing now?" some begin. "Hope this e-mail finds all the best on you." Flattering and solicitous and written in bewitchingly mangled English, the e-mails have the hallmarks of spam offering carnal pleasure—except they are actually far tamer. They are invitations to attend scientific meetings in China organized by a company that bills itself as the "World Leading Provider of Intelligence Exchanges in Life Sciences."

BIT Life Sciences, based in Dalian, a seaside city in Northeast China, stages conferences on a staggering array of topics, from vaccines and biodiversity to diabetes, cancer, cloud computing, HIV/AIDS, and algae. The meetings, which are often billed as an "Annual World Congress," sometimes coin names for new disciplines, such as "Endobolism" and "Drug Designology." BITeomics, the parent company, says it has 400 employees and holds at least 70 conferences a year that "tens of thousands of people" have attended since 2001.

Welcome to the bizarre world of what some call "predatory" conferences: scientific confabs, sometimes sparsely attended, that seem to come into being primarily to make money. Jeffrey Beall, a librarian at the University of Colorado, Denver, who monitors a subset of open-access journals that he calls "predatory," sees a similar phenomenon in BIT conferences. "They have the same conflict of interest as predatory publishers," he asserts. While predatory journals charge fees to publish papers, these conferences make money through registration fees that are bundled with charges for accommodation, meals, and program materials. (Typical bills run in the \$2000 range. BIT, which

pay the registration fee. "This stuff reminds me of the *Who's Who* business model," Lowe says. "You can be in this book of luminaries if you'll just pay for the book."

While BIT Congress claims to be "the largest-scale conference company in Asia Pacific," it has competition in what Beall says is an expanding industry. "They're just one in the landscape," he says. He has also taken aim at the OMICS Group, a company based in India that stages conferences and publishes open-access journals that Beall considers "predatory" (see p. 60). (OMICS strongly objects to being deemed "predatory" by Beall and has threatened to sue him for \$1 billion.)

Vanity publishers

In addition to publishers with a questionable reputation that pester scientists, there are also a number of enterprises that actively approach students with unsolicited offers. They are known as 'vanity publishers.' Students are usually asked whether they would like to publish their Master's thesis in print form, with the publisher concerned ultimately aiming to benefit financially from this. These publishers actively approach TU Delft students after they have uploaded their theses onto the <u>TU Delft Repository</u>.

This results in copyright being transferred to the publisher, which can lead to problems with future publications based on the Master's thesis.

TU Delft emphatically advises students not to work with these publishers; publishing with such companies never brings any added value. Always check a publisher's reputation and carefully check the conditions of any agreement. The most important vanity publisher is Omniscriptum, which operates user a number of names or imprints, including Scholars' Press and LAP Lambert. The latter is especially active and sends many TU Delft students soliciting e-mails, such as the one below:

Australian Higher Education Research Data Collections

What is HERDC?

HERDC stands for 'Higher Education Research Data Collection'. It's an annual government reporting requirement, comprising research data (income and publications) from all Australian tertiary institutions. The data collected is used to determine government research block grant (RBG) funding allocations to the tertiary sector, and is therefore of vital importance to the University. The annual HERDC specifications set out the criteria for eligibility in each publication category. CSU is legally required to collect and retain documentation showing how these criteria have been met for each publication it claims.

Tips on what can/should be entered for HERDC:

Books:

- Books must be either:
 - a) published by a commercial publisher and offered for sale, OR
 - b) peer reviewed
- Textbooks, anthologies, reference books (eg. dictionaries, encyclopaedias), manuals, guides, resource booklets, handbooks etc are specifically <u>excluded</u> from HERDC

- Published theses are now specifically <u>excluded</u> from HERDC
- LAP (Lambert Academic Publishers) and VDM Verlag DO NOT meet the commercial publisher criteria. Books produced by these publishers should not be entered on MyResearch for HERDC.
- Research-related reports (eg. funded or published by Govt. or public agencies or external institutes) should be entered into MyResearch in the Reports category.
- You must have been either the <u>sole author or a co-author</u> of the entire book to enter a publication as a book – ie, <u>editorship of a book does not count for HERDC purposes</u>

Chapters:

- Chapters must be either:
 - a) in a book published by a commercial publisher and offered for sale, OR
 - b) peer reviewed
- Chapters in textbooks, reference book entries forewords, brief introductions, brief editorials and appendices are <u>unlikely</u> to meet the criteria for HERDC
- Revised chapters are only eligible if they constitute substantial (> 50%) new knowledge/material and constitute original research
- Note that introductions and conclusions need to be more than a summary/overview in order to meet the HERDC definition of research
