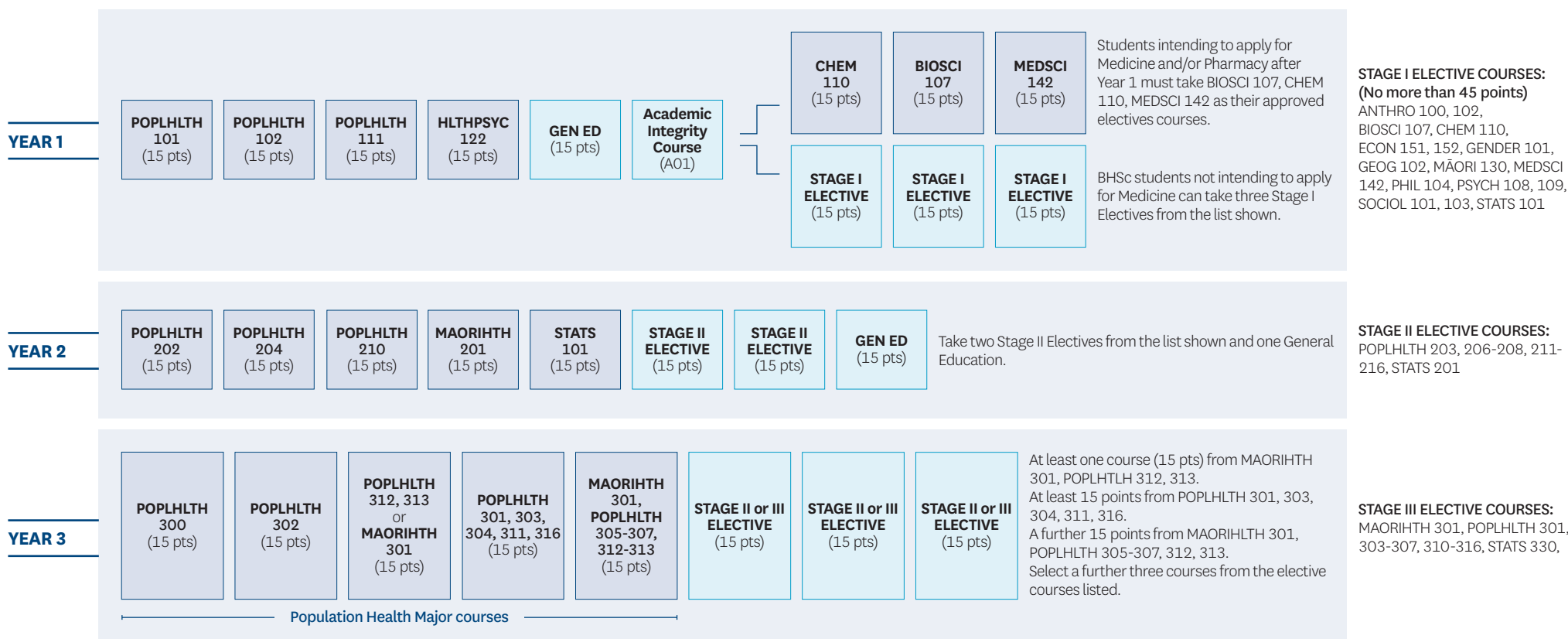

- 30 points (2 courses) must be taken from courses offered in either the General Education Open Schedule or the General Education Faculty Schedule approved for this degree.
 - A student who is required to meet the Academic English Language Requirement, may substitute an approved academic English course for 15 points General Education.
 - In order to meet the requirements for General Education students must pass the Academic Integrity Course.
