A scholarship may be awarded only to a student who is or becomes enrolled at a New Zealand University for a course of study approved by the Trustees. The Trustees may award one or more of such scholarships in each year.

A scholarship may be awarded only to a student who satisfies the Trustees that he or she was born in Poland or that at least one of his or her direct ancestors was born in Poland.

Those persons only shall be regarded as having been born in Poland who have been born:

- (a) within the geographical limits of the country commonly known as Poland at 28 May 1984;
- (b) within the geographical limits at the time of their birth of the country then commonly known as Poland;
- (c) prior to 31 December 1921 within the geographical limits as at 31 December 1921 of the country at that date commonly known as Poland;
- (d) on the high seas or to a parent engaged in the diplomatic service in circumstances entitling them to Polish citizenship.

Applications for a scholarship shall be submitted to the Trustees by 31 October in each year. The Trustees shall determine what scholarships shall be awarded and to whom and shall fix the amount of each scholarship so awarded. The Trustees shall have regard to the following criteria:

- (a) the past scholastic record of the applicant;
- (b) the aptitude and suitability of the applicant for the proposed course of study;
- (c) the financial needs of the applicant;
- (d) the interest of the applicant in and his or her contribution or likely future contribution to Polish culture and to the Polish community in New Zealand;
- (e) such other matters as the Trustees consider relevant.

Referees should not be asked to send their references to you. However, if the form states that references are to be attached to it referees may provide them to you either open or in a sealed envelope. Uncertified copies of references are not acceptable.
