
Click on the + icon to add resources to your existing Canvas module.


Step 2:

Step 1:


Select the link text and click the link icon from the top menu.

Step 1:


From the left-hand menu on Canvas click the Commons icon.


Step 2:


Search for 'Learning essentials: Academic skills module'.

Click on Add App. and rename as appropriate. Insert Hub URL and tick 'Show in Course Navigation'.
