

Our policy regarding: REPEAT PRESCRIPTIONS

DO I NEED TO SEE THE DOCTOR?

- Repeat prescriptions without the need to see your doctor are available to enrolled patients with certain stable conditions.
- A previous visit to prescribe the medication at this Health Centre is required and repeat prescriptions without seeing the doctor should have been discussed and recorded in your medical records.
- You will still need to see your doctor at regular intervals for monitoring to review your progress

HOW DO I REQUEST A REPEAT PRESCRIPTION?

- You can visit or contact the Health Centre by phone (09 923 7681) / fax/email uhcsnurse@auckland.ac.nz.
- All requests for repeat prescriptions will be handled by the practice nurse who will get in touch with you if there are any questions or concerns about your request.

FEES FOR A REPEAT PRESCRIPTION

Additional charge for faxing script to a pharmacy

Students: \$5.00 additional

COLLECTION TIMES:
