Foundation Studies Certificate

The Foundation Studies Certificate programme, owned by the University of Auckland and delivered by Taylors College in Auckland, is a comprehensive university preparation programme tailored to international students. Once you successfully complete the Foundation Studies Certificate programme and meet the entry requirements for your chosen undergraduate degree, you can begin your degree studies at the University of Auckland.

Foundation Studies Certificate – standard length

Minimum age: 16

Intakes: January, July and August

Programme length: 3-4 terms (46/47/42 weeks depending on intake date)

English language requirements: IELTS score of 5.0 (no band less than 4.5), or approved equivalent

Tuition fee: NZ\$28,600*

Foundation Studies Certificate – intensive length

Minimum age: 16

Intakes: April and October

Programme length: 3 terms (33/35 weeks)

English language requirements: IELTS score of 5.5 (no band less than 5.0), or approved equivalent

Tuition fee: NZ\$28,600*

You can now apply for the Foundation Studies Certificate programme (all 2021 start dates) using a selection of approved English tests, including the Duolingo English Test (DET). Pre-Foundation programme

Taylors College Auckland offers the Pre-Foundation programme for students who do not meet the entry requirements for the Foundation Studies Certificate programme. Once you have successfully completed the Pre-Foundation programme and met the English entry requirement, you can apply for the Foundation Studies Certificate programme. If you acquire sufficient credits during your Pre-Foundation programme, you will also receive a New Zealand Certificate in Foundation Skills (Level 2).

Pre-Foundation programme

Minimum age: 16

Intakes: January and July

Programme length: 19 weeks (21 weeks including holiday)

English language requirements: IELTS score of 4.5 (writing no less than 4.5), or approved equivalent

Tuition fee: NZ\$14,300*

New Zealand Certificate in Foundation Skills (Level 2)

This course, developed by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA), is delivered by Study Group NZ Limited trading as Taylors College.
