The minimum requirement is as follows:  IELTS: 6.5 overall (with no individual component score lower than 5.5) TOEFL iBT: 88 (R=22, L=21, S=23, W=22)   |
|                               | If your level of English falls below this, you may be able to take one of the pre-sessional English courses which take place in the summer before enrolment in September. These vary in length between six and 16 weeks, depending upon your current English language score.
