Language Requirement	Valid Proof of English Language Proficiency (Official TOEFL, IELTS or Duolingo results). Minimum 85 IBT and at least 20 on each subsection; Minimum 6.5 IELTS with at least 6.5 on each subsection; or Minimum 115 Duolingo with at least 105 on each section. Students who are completing an undergraduate degree at a university in country where English is the official language or from the American College of Thessaloniki, and Yale-NUS are not required to fulfill this requirement.
GPA Requirement	3.0 on a 4.0 scale
Required fees paid by students *ESTIMATES*	\$321 per semester or \$642 per year - Sports Center fee, Technology Fee, Metro's University Pass Student Health Insurance - \$940 for Fall only, \$2243 for Academic Year, \$1303 for Spring only **Please see student costs table below**
Insurance Information	Students are automatically covered by the American University student insurance. The possibility to waive the AU health insurance will require proof of insurance that meets a number of requirements, including the insurance plan must be provided by a company licensed to do business in the United States, with a claims payment office and a US Phone number. Students should be prepared to pay for the AU student health insurance.
Housing	At this time, we cannot provide campus housing. Students should expect to find their own off-campus housing. They can use the AU Off-campus Housing site: https://www.american.edu/ocl/housing/off-campus-housing-services.cfm

Notes:

***Cost guide below is created for the purposes of acquiring a visa.** Tuition is charged per semester. If a course requires a lab fee, this is an additional cost that will be added to the student's Mandatory Fees.

Important Additional Costs

Students must be able to meet the following costs as they apply to their particular situation:

- * SEVIS and J1 visa fees - currently \$380
- * Travel expenses between home country and Washington DC, and during vacation periods
- * Large purchases (such as computers, furniture, etc...)
- * Medical expenses not covered by health insurance (eye care, dental care, or Medical problems developed before arriving at the university)
